FFA NATIONAL POLICY re JEWELLERY

Soccer NSW advises members of the following 2005 FIFA guidelines concerning the wearing of jewellery. This will take effect 1 January 2006 for all state competitions that commence after that date.

FIFA LAWS OF THE GAME

LAW 4 – PLAYERS' EQUIPMENT

SAFETY – "A player must not use equipment or wear anything that is dangerous to himself or another player (including any kind of jewellery)."

This includes anti-discrimination bands, leather necklaces and any other loose wristbands.

The taping of jewellery is no longer allowed (including earrings and wedding rings).

Sweatbands may be worn.

Any player not complying with these regulations will not be allowed to play.
