He will be sorely missed in the football community and by so many at Seaforth FC.

Secretary's Report Al Glixman

From the perspective of the Club Secretary, it's been a quiet but positive year. The NSW government has finally confirmed that they will not be proceeding with the Beaches Link tunnel – so we've got the outcome we wanted that aligns with all of our advocacy and engagement over the years – it was worth it. However, it's out of the frying pan and into the fire because the Northern Beaches Council is now considering building a bike track in the lower car park. That has the potential to significantly reduce parking for our members. Together with the MWFA we've raised our concerns about this and our engagement with council is ongoing as part of the development of the Plan of Management for Seaforth Oval. We'll keep you updated.

New 24x7 Defibrillator (AED)

The safety of our members has received a boost with the installation at Seaforth Oval of a life saving defibrillator (AED) which is available 24x7. It's mounted on the ground floor of the club house near the Visitor's change room. We thank the MWFA for their support with obtaining this vital piece of equipment.

Treasurer's Report Paul Thompson

Results for 2023

The Club had a 30 September 2023 result of a \$17,452 accounting profit (accounting profit of \$33,014 in 2022). The club continues to be managed conservatively to produce in the range of small profits or losses with the intention that the resources of the club are used to best effect.

The club was able to have a reasonably normal season in 2023 with the financials looking standard. As always, anything the club makes is then re-invested back into gear, player development and the overall costs of running a club. The continued challenges of attracting volunteers to vital club roles means we have had to restructure our relationship with volunteers to attract and maintain contributors to the club – this will be discussed later.

The overall revenue of the club was up on 2022 as we see a more normalised season. Added to this we saw an increase in member numbers from 1,590 to 1,612 members. This remains below Pre COVID times, but we hope that the noticeable improvements being made to the club with club merchandise, the canteen, gear provided for training and matches, Academy developments and overall facilities means we keep, if not expand upon, our membership.

The club remains one of the largest clubs on the Northern Beaches and has expenses that reflect that, and unlike some clubs don't have the supplemental income created by synthetic pitches. Fee increases are not something that we take lightly, and we retained our fees at the same levels as pre 2022 (before the return of registration fees), our intention is to keep them as flat as possible compared to Pre COVID times into 2023. We know that the MWFA will increase fees again in 2024 and Services NSW is reducing the Active Kids voucher system benefits – we will again look to balance these effects with the pressures of running a football club to the level of expectations of members.

We continue to see pleasing support from a wider variety of sponsors, and this really helps us to offer services and activities to those who wish to take advantage of them. The terrific efforts of Graham Whitehead and the support of our terrific sponsors has seen an increase in revenue from this area in exchange for fantastic exposure for our local partners. Without a supplementary income, that other clubs have, then the continued support of our sponsors remains important for the club's growth.

Variances from Prior Years

We have continued to expand our development costs for coaching, ensuring that all coaches were paid for the full season despite various challenges, and training and information nights as we look to help provide the tools for members to understand and enjoy their football.

As alluded to before, because of the increasing pressures on certain roles and the ongoing challenges with recruiting volunteers we have taken the decision to change some of these roles to be paid positions. The intention is that the paid roles sit within a certain payment range but also mean that amounts can be reduced in times where the club does not attract as many players or sponsorship. We hope that this means that we attract and retain people to the club who can devote time and energy to support our efforts.

Certain costs for lighting and player costs did not make the cut off for the prior year end and we saw those costs in 2023. We have again taken the opportunity to order shirts for 2024 well in advance to try and reduce the logistical rush before the season starts – this also means that we are now on a regular cycle of having paid for a significant expense before our revenues reach us for the season.

The club continues to expand its ideas of sustainability as we continue to hand out only club annual trophies. In addition, the club has increased its efforts to reduce the number of shirts being purchased - with over 400 members not taking up a new shirt and reusing the one from last season, via a member's discount for shirt renewal. We continue to believe that these initiatives are aligned with our members and offer the opportunity to manage our footprint.

Financial Position

The club continues to remain in a very good financial position with a strong cash position. The cash reserves of the club are held within a term deposit and are reserved against what we expect to be substantial requests from local Council for contributions towards capital works that the club will benefit from; there are significant amounts being contemplated for lighting at Tania Park and lighting upgrades at Quirk Road. The only benefit of recent interest rate rises is that the club can put this money to work in Term Deposits and earn some income which can be re-invested in the club.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2023

1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Preparation

The treasurer has prepared the financial statements on the basis that the club is a non-reporting entity because there are no users dependent on general purpose financial statements. These financial statements are therefore special purpose financial statements that have been prepared to meet the needs of the club.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with significant accounting policies disclosed below which the Treasurer has determined are appropriate to meet the purpose of preparation. Such accounting policies are consistent with the previous period unless stated otherwise.

The financial Statements have been prepared on a cash basis and are based on historical cost unless otherwise in the notes. The accounting policies that have been adopted in the preparation of these statements are as follows:

Income Tax

The club's income is not subject to income tax as all income is derived from members.

Property, Plant & Equipment and Depreciation

Property, plant & equipment are carried at cost. All assets, excluding freehold land and buildings are depreciated over their useful lives to the company. The depreciable amount of property, plant and equipment is depreciated on a straight-line basis. Depreciation commences from the time the asset is available for its intended use. The value of plant and equipment is reviewed annually to ensure it is not in excess of the recoverable amount from these assets.

Trade and other receivables

Memberships are not accepted without payment and therefore the club does not operate a trade receivables ledger.

Cash & Cash Equivalents

Cash & cash equivalents comprises cash on hand and short-term investment which are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value

Revenue and other income

Revenue is recognised when the amount of the revenue can be measured reliably. Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received and is presented net of return, discounts, and rebates.


Interest Revenue

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest rate method and in the case of bank interest, recognised at the rate payable by the bank at the time.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses, and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST. Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of GST. The net amount of GST recoverable from or payable to the ATO is included as part of receivables or payables in the balance sheet.
